Dear Parent & Player,

Please accept this letter as your invitation to be a member of Lady ProSkills Hunt. If you are ready to commit, please read this letter thoroughly and complete all forms. Signature by both player and parent is your written commitment to Hunt ProSkills Hunt for the 2024 season and agreement to abide by the following:

#### Proksills Hunt: A Commitment to the Team

As a ProSkills Hunt parent or player, your presence at every scheduled practice and game is expected. In case of unavoidable circumstances, you must inform the coach beforehand. Moreover, we have a strict policy against any negative behavior, whether from parents or players, during practices and games. Failure to meet the obligations stated in the Parent/Player Agreement may result in the suspension of a player's participation in the team's activities until the requirements are met.

#### Consequences for Late Arrival or Missed Practices and Games:

- 5 minutes or more late to practice - suicides & push-ups
- Missed practices - suicides & push-ups
- 3 consecutive missed practices - sit out one game of a tournament
- 5 consecutive missed practices - sit out one full tournament
- Failing school notices - sit out a minimum of one tournament
- Inappropriate use of social media - sit out two games of a tournament

If a player must sit out a tournament, they are expected to attend the practices and workouts as usual. The player must also attend all events to sit on the bench and cheer on the team. Additionally, the player must make a verbal apology to the coaches and teammates for their behavior that led to their suspension.

By acknowledging this form, both the parent and player agree to abide by the rules and consequences set forth by ProSkills Hunt.

## ProSkills Hunt: Financial Liability

### Fee Structure:

- Player fees are charged for the remaining duration of the 2024 Summer season and can be paid in full or via monthly installments from February to July
- The following fee structure applies:
  - Tournament players: \$200 registration fee, and \$325 monthly fee. This includes all tournament fees and # hours of practice per week.
  - Recreational Players: \$150 registration fee, and \$250 monthly dues.
- Fees are due as per the selected schedule during registration.
- The payment schedule is as follows:
  - March 5th: Registration/uniform
  - March 10th - July 10th: Monthly fee

### Registration and Payment:

- Player registration must be completed online before being added to the team group chat.
- All payments must be made electronically through an automatic payment process.
- Once registration is complete, you will be enrolled in the automatic draft outlined above unless you choose to pay in full.

### Additional Information:

- Fees do not cover travel expenses, such as airfare, hotel, ground transportation or meals for players or parents.
- No refunds will be granted at any time during the year.
- Once you agree to participate on a team, you are responsible for the financial commitment for the entire season. If you have an extenuating circumstance the maximum reimbursement will be half of the remaining balance for the season in which you are registered.
- Failure to bring your account current within 30 days of a balance on your account and not making prior payment arrangements will result in your child being barred from practice.

## Terms and Conditions for ProSkills Hunt Club Members

As a member of ProSkills Hunt, your commitment to the Club financially binds you for the 2024 summer season. Any payments made towards the Club are non-refundable, regardless of whether a Player withdraws for any reason, including injury, suspension, or release. All automatic payments for the upcoming month will be cancelled.

Here are some other important guidelines to consider:

- "24 Hour Rule": We ask that all parents abide by this rule, which means that they will not approach a coach or director to discuss team performance, playing time, or grievances within 24 hours of the end of a tournament or game.
- Fundraising: Although fundraising is available, you should be prepared to pay your monthly fees during the season. Please note that player travel, lodging, and meals are not included in team fees.
- Mandatory Practices: Attendance at Hunt United Basketball practices is mandatory, and being on time is essential. If you cannot attend practice or plan to be late, please notify your coach as soon as possible. Consequences will be assessed for missed practices or late arrivals.
- Team Reformation: Keep in mind that players are joining Hunt United Basketball and not a specific team. The Club reserves the right to transfer players between teams if the Director and/or coaches believe it is in the best interest of the player and the teams. If there's a difference in fees, the difference will be discussed before any transition is made.
- Tournament Participation: All players are expected to participate in every tournament. Injured players are expected to attend local tournaments for team support.
- Playing Time: Coaches reserve the right to play athletes based on the level of competition and the skill set of the athlete. Playing time is not guaranteed.
- Social Media Guidelines: All players are expected to use social media responsibly. Appropriate consequences will be assessed if a player conducts themselves in a manner that is unbecoming to the player, teammates, or organization.
